

SUPRT
Information & Assent/Permission (Youth under 18)

Introduction (for Youth)

The SOS grant helps pay for your services. It is funded by SAMHSA and run by the Ohio Department of Behavioral Health (DBH). Your program uses a tool called SUPRT which is a short optional survey. Doing it is your choice. Your choice will not change your services.

When You May Be Asked to Do SUPRT

- When you start services (Baseline)
- About 6 months later (Reassessment), if you are still in services
- Each year (Annual), if services continue
- A final survey will be completed by the agency when services are completed

What We Ask You to Do

- Answer a few questions about how you are doing.
- You may skip any question you do not want to answer.
- You and your parent/guardian may share a phone or email to get reminders- this is optional.

Your Choice (Youth Assent)

- You can say yes or no.
- Your services will be the same either way.
- You can stop at any time.

Parent/Guardian Permission

A parent or legal guardian must also agree before you take part. They can change their mind at any time.

Privacy

We protect your privacy. Your answers are used to help DBH see how services are working. Reports put many people's answers together and do not include your name. We follow privacy laws (such as HIPAA and 42 CFR Part 2).
