When you get services, we will share some of your information with groups who track and check to see if services are working. Those groups are the project evaluator, The Ohio Colleges of Medicine Government Resource Center, and the funders: Ohio Department of Behavioral Health and U.S. Department of Health and Human Services. Some of this information may be used to send you incentive payments if you are still getting services at about six months or a year from now and if you fill out a reassessment form called the SUPRT-C.
