## Step 3 – Request access to SOR SOS (State Opioid and Stimulant Response) app

- a) Go to URL: apps.mha.ohio.gov
- b) Click Request Access to an Application

c) Select SOR SOS (State Opioid and Stimulant Response) from the drop-down



d) Select a **Role** from the drop-down list. There are two choices of roles:

SOS Behavioral Health User – reserved for supervisors SOS Collector – most users (e.g., GPRA interviewers and data entry staff)







e) Select your Organization from the list.

If you do not see your organization's name on the list, click on "my organization isn't in the list" and you will be prompted to enter your **organization's Tax ID**.

f) Click Submit

The SOR/SOS iPortal will display a successful submission message and the request will have been sent to OhioMHAS admin. You should receive a copy of the email request.
